Energy from the wind powers this fun children's toy.



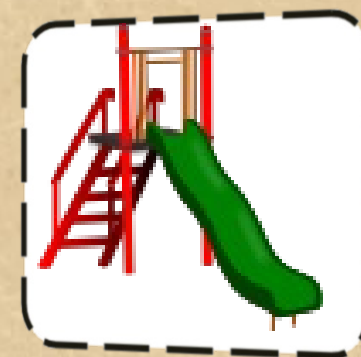
the birds are "molting." Find evidence of this animal adaptation.
