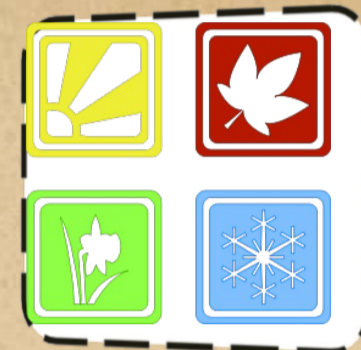




1) I am copper, about 5' in diameter and came from a Monroe, WI cheesemaker. I am set into the ground.

3) I am springfed, over 100' deep in spots, and used to provide sand and gravel in the early 1900's.



4) Made out of light and utility poles from the old city sewer plant, I am red and span water.



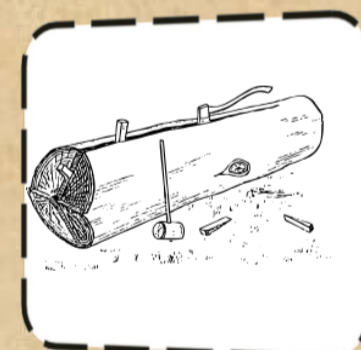
5) A stone Druid, I witness many weddings, with pine boughs cradled in my arms.

9) Built of brick and 2 stories tall, I was home to a cattle auctioneer and his family in the 1930s.



10) Horses were tied to me. Find me close to where RBG mail is left, outside of Clue #9.
