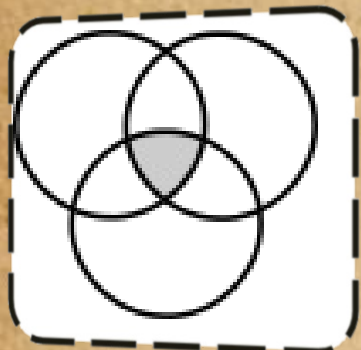


This provides the forum for students to share their thinking and process ideas and concepts through shared discourse...

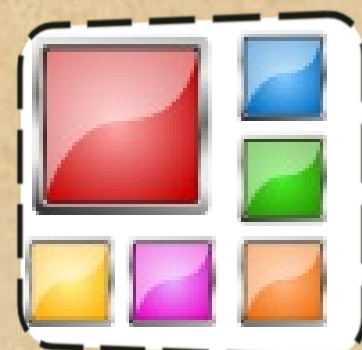

We use this strategy because it makes students an ACTIVE PART of whole class mini-lessons, read-alouds, and activities. Allows all students to participate in conversations and practice speaking and listening skills. This is known as



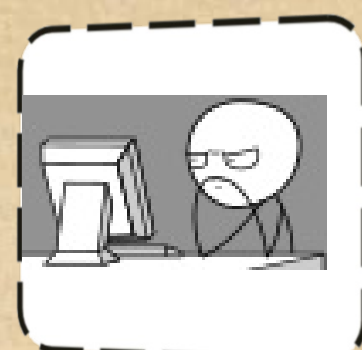
Students are cued to think before anyone responds. Students discuss their responses with a partner. Teacher listens in. Teacher calls on selected students to share their responses with the whole group. This is known as



Students discuss the question or topic with a partner. Teacher listens in. When signaled by the teacher, each pair of students finds another pair to join so that students are now in groups of four. This is known as



This sheet is used to document whether a student is doing well with practicing a skill, if the student needs to work on this, and/or if there are notes/plans for improvement. This is known as
