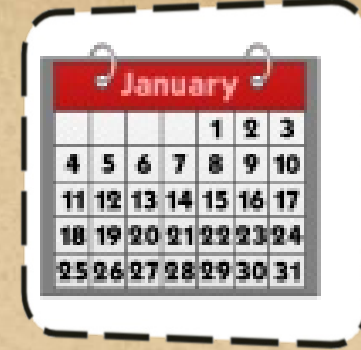
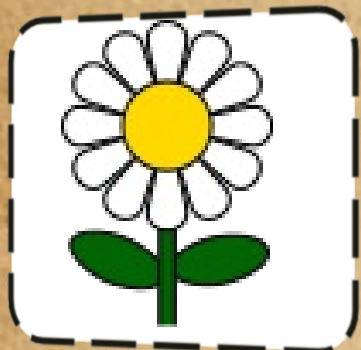




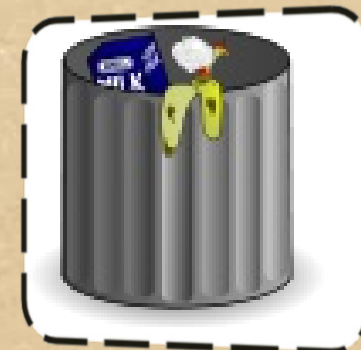
We just celebrated our first year as girl scouts! Find an official Girl Scout pin.

On Monday we bridged from Daises to _?_. Find some of these and some milk and enjoy a snack.



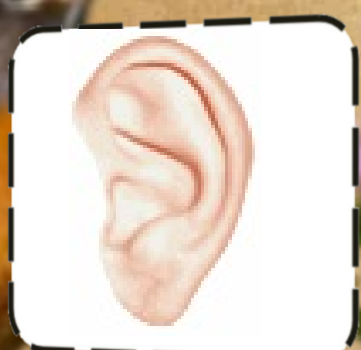
Juliette Gordon Low wanted girls to get involved in more physical activity like baseball. Do 5 jumping jacks, crunches, and push ups.



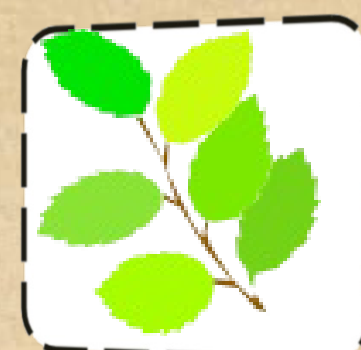
Juliette loved animals. Find an animal track and draw what kind of animal it's from.
