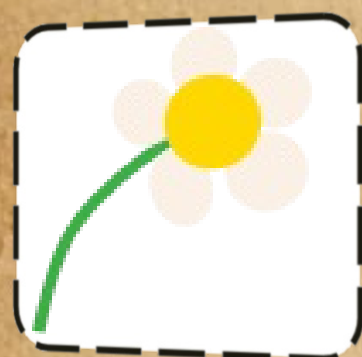




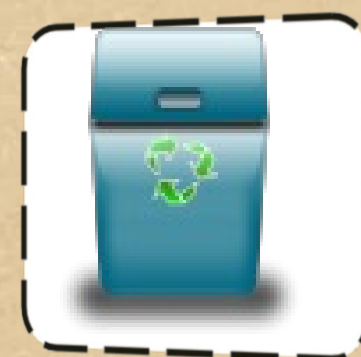
We celebrated a 100 years of Girl Scouts in 2012. Find something that has one of the same numbers.



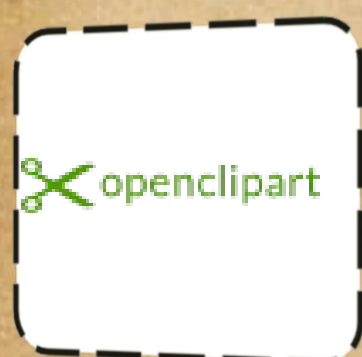
