Frogs and snakes love the Spring. Look and listen for signs of either. Draw a picture on the back.




Some seeds have a protective case. Like pinecones and acorns. See if you can find three of these.



Spiders of many kinds are in the park. Spot a spider or a spider web.




Birds as they grow, lose feathers. Try finding one bird feather.
