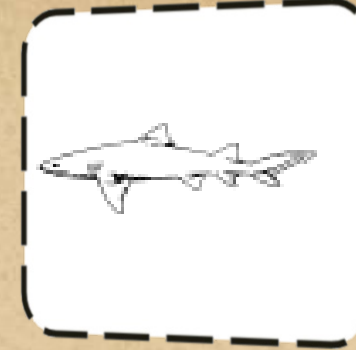




What do you call a free floating animal that drifts with the currents



Stop by the shark touch tank. Touch a shark! Can you describe how sharks skin feels?



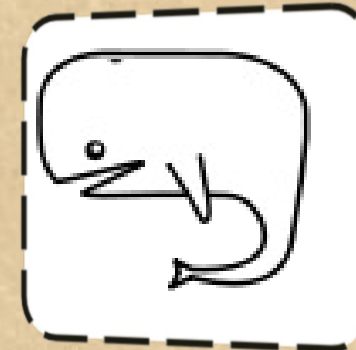
Visit the coral reef exhibit. How many eels can you find in the exhibit?

Take your picture by an Iceberg. Meet some passengers of the Titanic and be able to tell one of their stories.



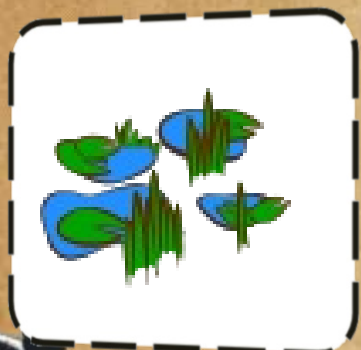
Visit the Beluga Whales and have your picture taken with one. Get to know them, and be able to call them by their nickname.
