DESTINATION 1: We use this fringed garment to touch the Torah when we read from it. Take a video and a picture of your team saying the blessing as you put it over you.



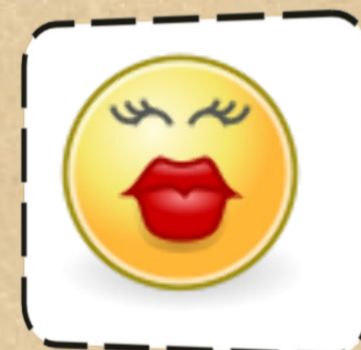
DESTINATION 2: Take a video of your team singing L'cha Dodi in front of the Shtender.
