Energy from the wind powers this children's toy.



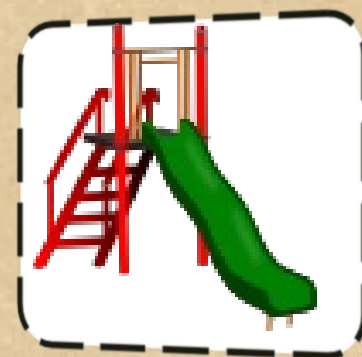
The birds are "molting". Find evidence of this animal adaptation.

Older students: In a plant, this is where photosynthesis occurs. Younger students: We jump in piles of these in the Fall.



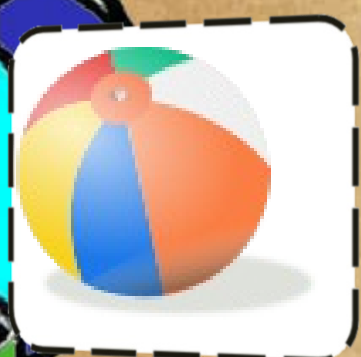
An inclined plane on the playground that moves you down on your bottom. Draw a picture of this on the back.
